



THE FOURTH ADVENT SUNDAY-A

A fundamental conviction is expressed in Christian piety by the role given to Mary the Mother of Jesus. From earliest times Mary has typified the perfected Church of the end-time. When Christians have asked themselves whether it is really possible that the redemption should be completed in the world by people themselves so unredeemed as yet, the veneration of the Immaculate Conception or total sinlessness of Mary, attributed to the foreseen merits of her Son, was a symbolic answer to that question. This doctrine of the Immaculate Conception was a way of saying that through Jesus Christ God has brought about a new and untainted creation, his bride Mary or his bride the Church, uncontaminated by the leaven of past evil, a special and merciful divine intervention.

Similarly, when Christians asked themselves whether the heavenly goal was really attainable, the answer was expressed in the veneration of the <u>Today's Prayer</u> The more we call on God the more we can feel God's presence. Day by day we are drawn closer to the loving heart of God.

Advent and Christmas 2016

Project : Elementary and Secondary Education Assistance to Children of Poor Families in the Parish of Saint-Augustine of Poko.

The following project plans to help children 18 years and younger who belong to poor families within our own parish. The project hopes to ensure that these children have access to a basic education program.

This project is part of an effort to mobilize resources towards the creation of a youth ministry program. The program would encourage parents to create a Christian environment within their families and help establish a Christian leadership group with a social development focus.

Overall yearly cost: 2000 EUROS

DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT

General Objective Ensure the yearly education of 10 school-aged children that belong to impoverished Christian families from Saint-Augustine Parish in Poko.

Specific Objectives

SO 1. To ensure the costs of educating 10 children in the area schools -5 girls and 5 boys under 18 years of age. SO 2. To ensure the travel of one child to Kinshasa so that he/she can attend a school in the Capital.

PLANS

1.To conduct a fundraiser campaign towards the education of children belonging to impoverished Christian families.

2. To pay the education expenses for the 10 children identified by the Parish of Saint-Augustin.

3. To ensure follow-up of the beneficiaries of this education program with their respective schools.

LENGTH OF THE PROJECT

The project covers a period of six years (starting in 2017) This period encompasses one complete cycle of primary and secondary education in the Democratic Republic of Congo.

MAINTENANCE OF THE PROJECT

1. The parents of the children benefitting from the program are organized under a small parish association that deals with the educational matters of parish youth.

2. Parents will contribute two pigs so that they can build communal pigst

3. The funds generated by this pigsty will contribute to the local initiatives run by the priest and help all men an women of good will.
